MATERIALS: ALPHABET CARDS PRINTED AND CUT OUT

SKILL: FIND OBJECTS OR ITEMS THAT MATCH THE LETTER



Print and cut out letter cards.



Have your child select a card from the pile and find as many objects or items around the house as they can.



Select a few letters sounds at a time to use. Try starting with the letters in your child's name or S, A, T, P, I, N.



Add more letters as your child masters different sounds.



Challenge your child by finding items that END with the letter sounds selected from the pile.
